

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
NORMAN, OKLAHOMA, COMMENDING AND EXTENDING
RECOGNITION TO THE STUDENTS AND FACULTY AT
NORMAN NORTH HIGH SCHOOL FOR THE 25TH YEAR
ANNIVERSARY OF NORMAN NORTH HIGH SCHOOL.

- § 1. WHEREAS, Norman North High School was established on August 21, 1997, at 1809 Stubbeman Avenue on the grounds where Longfellow Middle School was built in 1972; and
- 2 2. WHEREAS, Norman North High School was selected as a “2008 No Child Left Behind-Blue Ribbon School” and was recognized for their overall academic excellence, their focus on improving the school and creating an environment where all students can succeed, and their progress in closing achievement gaps among student subgroups; and
- § 3. WHEREAS, in 2009, Norman North High School was part of the 2009 Student Exchange Program with Israel and hosted 24 Israeli students for two weeks and when they left, Norman North students traveled with them back to Israel to learn about their culture; and
- § 4. WHEREAS, The Norman North High School Athletic Program has won 30 national championships with 22 State Runner-ups, and 162 students received National Merit Scholarships; and
- § 5. WHEREAS, in 9 years, Norman North High School students raised \$2,592,726 through SPUD (Students Performing Unselfish Deeds) that is used to support local individuals in need and social service organizations; and
- § 6. WHEREAS, since 1997, there have been 11,082 students graduate from Norman North High School; notable graduates were Trae Young who plays for the Atlanta Hawks,, Jordan Evans who plays for the Cincinnati Bengals, Josh Bonzie, Actor/Comedian; Owen Joyner, Actor; and Maggie McClure, singer/songwriter/actress.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORMAN, OKLAHOMA:

- § 7. That the Council of the City of Norman, on behalf of the entire citizenry of Norman, commends and extends appreciation to the students and faculty of Norman North High School for the 25th Year Anniversary of Norman North High School.
