Just to confirm what was agreed upon during our video conference yesterday afternoon and what, per the email below, I believe Marc Goodell had already agreed upon with Aric, AT&T will be placing all handholes in the portion of Meadowbrook Glens north of 10 Mile Rd. We will be using handholes (flush mounts) rather than pedestals (towers) for the installment of our new fiber optic infrastructure within this portion of the subdivision.

As requested, I will reach out to our field inspector assigned to the project, Dan Schwab, to check on the date when our placing contractor can return and continue the build and also for an estimated completion date.
