RCM 23-06-03 Moved by Staudt, seconded by Crawford; CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY:

2. Consideration of amending Council Organization Rules and Order of Business

City Manager Cardenas said staff took the comments from the previous meeting and the proposed amendment is included in the packet. City Attorney Schultz said this addresses the concerns about requests for controversial proclamations, yet still allows for the Mayor to make exceptions for unusual circumstances. Anyone would still be allowed to speak during audience comments.

Member Crawford pointed out there is an inconsistency in the wording in the Boards and Commission section. Number 4, 5, 8, and 9 all mean the same thing but are worded differently. He asked for that to be looked at for consistency.
