

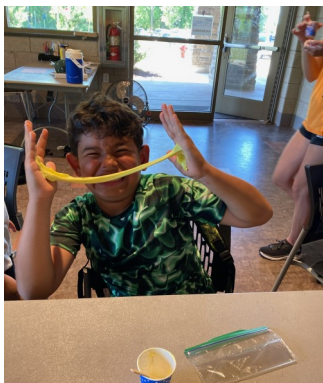


2024 Novi Summer Camps
