SUBJECT: Approval to purchase twenty-four (24) modems for the Novi Police Department patrol vehicles from CDW Government, sole source provider for Oakland County Courts and Law Enforcement Management Information System (CLEMIS), at the cost of \$34,920, and amend the budget.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City's Police Department currently has twenty-four (24) marked police cars. Each of these 24 vehicles has an operating modem that sends the vehicle's precise location. Oakland County CLEMIS, the entity who oversees the facilitation of public data across the county, has notified the Police Department that our current in-car modems will reach their end of life in May 2023. The modems will be considered obsolete and will need to be replaced to avoid service interruption, meaning the functionality of the current modems sending GPS data to CAD may be lost. Further, the modems will no longer have the ability to receive configuration updates or programming changes.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approval to purchase twenty-four (24) modems for the Novi Police Department patrol vehicles from CDW Government, sole source provider for Oakland County Courts and Law Enforcement Management Information System (CLEMIS) at the cost of \$34,920, and amend the budget.
