SUBJECT: QUOTA LIQUOR LICENSES UPDATE
DATE: OCTOBER 16, 2025

We have received notification from the Michigan Liquor Control Commission (LCC) that two previously issued quota licenses have been returned to the City of Novi. When a business fails to renew its license, it is deemed abandoned and reverts to the original issuing government entity. With the return of these two, the City now has a total of three available quota licenses. Ardiana's Restaurant (10 mile and Meadowbrook Rd.) has submitted an application and will be considered for one of them at the City Council meeting on Monday, October 21.
