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RCOC TO CONDUCT INFO. MEETING JULY 15 FOR 2027 ROUNDABOUT CONSTRUCTION AT 9 MILE/NAPIER INTERSECTION IN NOVI/LYON TWP.

Beverly Hills, Mich. — The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) will conduct a public information meeting next Wednesday, July 15, to share information about the planned 2027 construction of a roundabout at the 9 Mile Road/Napier Road intersection on the Novi/Lyon Township border.

The meeting will take place from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Novi Civic Center, 45175 10 Mile Road in Novi. The meeting will be open-house format – there will not be a formal presentation, but anyone interested can stop in at any time during the meeting to review plans and speak with RCOC staff.

The project will include:

- Converting the two current T-intersections into a single modern roundabout.
- Reconstructing approximately 0.34 miles of road around the roundabout.
- Paving the roundabout with asphalt.
- Placing curb and gutter around the roundabout.
- Installing pedestrian crosswalks at all legs of the roundabout.
- Improving storm sewers and drainage in the area.
- Installing intersection lighting at the roundabout.

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The roundabout construction is expected to start in the spring of 2027 and be completed by the end of the summer. However, the City of Novi will install a watermain at the intersection in the fall of 2026, tree removal in anticipation of the roundabout construction will take place during the 2026/27 winter and utility relocation work will start in the 2026/27 winter and conclude in the spring of 2027.

During the roundabout construction, the intersection will be closed to traffic.

During the closure, the detour route for east/west traffic will be 9 Mile Road to Garfield Road to 8 Mile Road to Currie Road and back to 9 Mile Road and vice versa. The detour route for north/south traffic will be 8 Mile Road to Currie Road to 10 Mile Road and back to Napier and vice versa.

The project will cost approximately \$2 million and will be paid for with federal road funds, RCOC dollars and contributions from the City of Novi, Lyon Township and Oakland County general government (through the Tri-Party Program).

Anyone who wishes to attend the meeting and requires special accommodations in accordance with the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) or federal Title VI, including those requiring language assistance, should contact the RCOC Engineering Department at 248-645-2000, ext. 2265. RCOC will provide such services free of charge with reasonable advance notice.
