Explanation: This will be a larger park addition to the City and it's likely future primary use will be parkland and natural areas surrounding the POPs Facility and the stormwater pond. The Small Area Committee and Plan focused primarily on park amenities to potentially be added in the future. The name Central Park evokes importance and priority through it's location and proximity to downtown; it ties well into promotion of future development on the north end of the property, highlighting a close connection to parkland for future residents; it also elicits the context of this being a central cultural hub for New Prague residents for gathering and to bring nature and all the benefits that trees and greenspace (over time) will bring into the City.

Please note that my proposal is for the entire area to be called **Central Park**, and for the Praha Outdoor Performance Stage to be one amenity (along with other future potential amendities) within the park.
