Dear Bruce:

We have reviewed the bids received on December 17, 2025 for the above referenced project. A bid summary form and detailed tabulation of the bid results is enclosed. We have checked the bids for mathematical accuracy and compliance with the bid specifications. We are hereby prepared to offer the following recommendation.

There were six (6) responsive bids received ranging in price from \$2,812,540.00 to \$3,829,326.00. The apparent low bid evaluated was received from Greystone Construction of Shakopee, Minnesota, who submitted a total price of \$2,812,540.00. Bids were received from contractors in the area including Corcoran, Faribault, Austin, and Mankato.

DGR Engineering conducted a post-bid interview with Greystone Construction to discuss the project design, scope and overall project schedule. Greystone had no concerns about the forementioned items and their perspective on the project construction aligned with DGR's expectations. Greystone's previous experience includes projects reasonably similar in complexity and size to the New Prague West Energy Station. We recommend that you award the contract to Greystone Construction for a total price of \$2,812,540.00

Overall, we saw significant interest in the project, as indicated by the number of bids submitted. In addition to the forementioned six (6) bids, one (1) non-responsive bid was received, and another bid was late and was left unopened. The bid amounts were tightly grouped indicating very competitive pricing for this project.
