SUBJECT: Fire Department LED Sign - Bid Award Recommendation

The City of Oelwein - Fire Department has been awarded a \$45,000 grant from the FEMA-SAFER grant for a double-sided LED sign. The purpose of the sign if to enhance marketing and recruitment-retention efforts for the Oelwein Fire Department.

On April 17, 2023 the bid process was initiated for this project. Request for proposals was provided to seven reputable vendors. Five vendors responded that they had an interest in the project and three vendors conducted site visits/virtual meetings to discuss the project. The proposal deadline was set for May 30, 2023. On the date of the deadline, the city received one proposal. A few days after the deadline, an additional vendor submitted a proposal. An additional vendor, that had conducted a site visit, indicated that their representative fell ill with Covid19 and they were not able to submit a proposal in time. A review of the proposal received within the timeline, showed that the proposal did not meet the bid specifications. A review of the late bid reflected the same. The City of Oelwein and grant funded items generally desire to see at least three bids on a project.

On June 6, 2023, a second RFP was disseminated to the three vendors that had conducted site visits and maintained communication. This RFP provided further clarification on the project and detailed the areas in which the received RFP's were deficient. This second RFP had a deadline of June 20, 2023. At the time of the deadline, one company had submitted a proposal. Again, in the interest of receiving at least three competitive bids, we made personal contact with all three vendors and met with them to discuss the project and reason for not receiving more than one bid. The two vendors that failed to submit a bid advised that they misunderstood the deadline and wording listing them as the general contractor. The vendor that had submitted their proposal in time, needed further clarification on the project as their bid did not meet all areas of the bid specification.

Each of these vendors advised that they understood the project parameters and they were provided a new deadline of July 18th to provide a proposal. Again, only one company provided a proposal on time. The other two vendors provided their proposals after the deadline with one providing a proposal on July 24th and the other on July 26th.

The following outlines those proposals:

1) Nesper Sign Advertising (Cedar Rapids): This vendor was late on each submission. Their final proposal is the lowest bid by approximately \$191, however, this proposal is not within the specs for the project as it is an 8mm display and the final specs called for a 6 mm display. Other vendors provided a 6 mm option as required. Their final proposal price for the qualifying sign =

\$44,809.52

2) Nagle Signs Inc. (Waterloo): This vendor was late on each submission. We had to reach out to them each step of the way to obtain information and proposals. Their final proposal price for the qualifying sign =

\$47,810.14

3) Varsity Group Marketing & Signs (Urbandale): This vendor was timely in each submission. Their final proposal price for the qualifying sign = \$44,993.00

After receiving the bids, we received late notice from FEMA on a new requirement for the sign project. The Oelwein Fire Department sits in a flood zone. In order to continue with the project, FEMA is now requiring that the electrical component connections and the lowest part of the LED sign be at least four feet above ground. This late requirement would increase the size of the posts for the sign as well as the length of the electrical run for the project.

A conversation was had with Varsity Group on this new requirement. They estimated an additional cost of \$350 to meet those guidelines. Further discussion with Varsity Group has them agreeing to reduce that expense so that we can come within budget for this project. Varsity Group has agreed to a final proposal price of \$44,998 for this project.

I would respectfully recommend Varsity Group Marketing & Signs bid of \$44,998 for the double-sided LED sign project. The grant provides 100% reimbursement for this project and is within the grant budgeted amount.




