# **Oelwein NE Sanitary Sewer Improvements (2023)**

## Weekly Construction Update

The intent of this weekly update is to give an overview of where construction has been, and where it should be in the next week. It is intended to be a general overview and be tentative in nature. Things may differ from the listed schedule if weather or other unknown factors come into play.



The purpose of this project is to improve maintenance and capacity of the sanitary sewer system. This will be accomplished by reducing rainwater inflow and infiltration (I & I), reducing the number of bottlenecks, and increasing pipe size. A benefit will be a reduction in basement backups and system overflows.

**Site A** is located on 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE from 3<sup>rd</sup> Street NE to 5<sup>th</sup> Street NE, then over to 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE up to 6<sup>th</sup> Street NE

**Site B** is located on 2<sup>nd</sup> St NE from N. Frederick Avenue to 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue NE.

- Dave Schmitt Construction (Schmitt) mobilized material and equipment to Site A.
- Received delivery of 12-inch diameter pipe & structures. Waiting for more 12-inch diameter pipe.

### What to expect next week: July 24<sup>th</sup> (Monday) – July 28<sup>th</sup> (Friday)

- Expect delivery of 12-inch diameter pipe July 21st & 24th.
- Expect construction to resume July 24<sup>th</sup> (Monday).
