## RESOLUTION APPROVING SALE OF CITY OWNED REAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 501 W. CHARLES

WHEREAS, the City of Oelwein, Iowa owns the following described real estate:

WHEREAS, the City Council also discussed the value of the real estate, the value to the community of the potential uses for the property, and in consideration of the above and foregoing, determined it to be appropriate and in the best interests of the City to approve the sale of said property to Rockie G. Williams and Jennifer Williams, for the sum of \$100.00

Section 1.	The property described herein shall be transferred to Rockie G. Williams and Jennifer
	Williams, for the sum of \$100.00.

- Section 3. The property shall be transferred by Quit Claim Deed with no abstract to be provided.
- Section 4. The Quit Claim Deed, and related Clerk's Affidavit, shall be recorded at the expense of the City.
- Section 5. The Mayor shall be authorized to execute the QCD, and any other documents related to the approved transfer of this property as set forth above.
- Section 6. This resolution shall be in effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
