Treated 23,520,000 gallons of waste water

Largest daily flow was 838,000 gallons.

Average daily flow was 759,000 gallons.

Applied 120,000 gallons of biosolids to the reed beds

Achieved a **96.7** % Biochemical Oxygen Demand removal

Achieved a 95.6 % Total Suspended Solids removal

Analyzed **522** wastewater samples in the cities state certified laboratory

39 samples submitted to Test America for testing.
