Resolution Resuming Payment to the Fayette County Landfill Commission for Recycling Fees

WHEREAS, the Oelwein City Council will resume payments to the Fayette Country Landfill Commission; and

WHEREAS, The City of Oelwein continues to have the following requests for the Landfill Commission;

- The Commission works with local businesses in Oelwein to host the recycle bins
- The Commission manages all recycling sites and takes responsibility for cleanup
- The Commission works toward a new and improved 28E agreement as stated in the 28E
- Responsibilities of cities and the county are spelled out by the commission so that each entity understands the service level they are paying for from the commission
- The Commission gathers research on comparable landfill commissions to understand if the current Commission provides a competitive service
- The Commission investigates the funding it would take to go to a single stream recycling service
- The Commission looks into the ability to provide curbside recycling to the residents of the county
