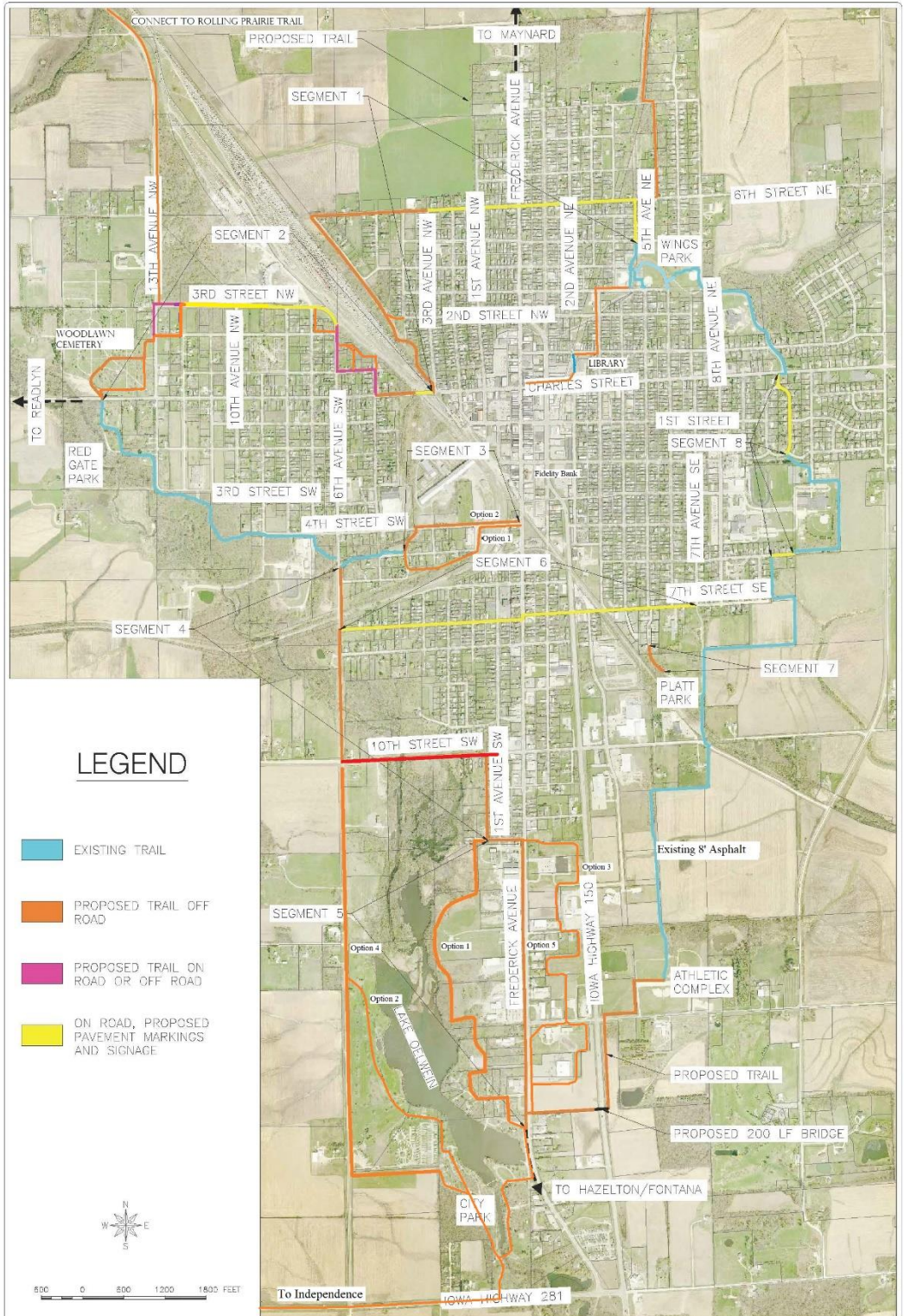

Staff requesting permission to pursue the currently unexpected (TAP) transportation alternative program money that is currently available in the amount of \$171,000. This federal funding is available in the federal fiscal years (FY) 2025-2028. This funding became available due to a previously awarded project in Clayton County being cancelled. This trail segment would be ten foot wide concrete due to federal requirements and would start on 6th Ave SW and continue 2,233' to South Frederick Ave as a part of the 10th Street bridge project. Engineer estimates are \$436,000 for construction and \$118,000 in engineering fees.

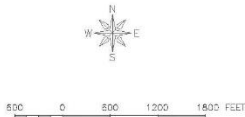
