- Evaluate if it is a problem
- How staff works
- Hear both sides of the story
- How do you plan when leadership changes every two years
- You are not in charge of staff, the Administrator does the day to day
 - Communication goes from Council to admin to staff, staff to admin to council
- You set policy for the city
- Your most important job is making sure the City Administration is doing theirs
