RESOLUTION APPROVING SALE AND TRASFER OF CITY'S OWNED REAL ESTATE LOCATED AT 632
5th AVENUE SW, OELWEIN, FAYETTE COUNTY, IOWA

WHEREAS, the City of Oelwein, Iowa owns the following described real estate:

Lot 5 and the South half of Lot 4, Block 1, Irvine's Sub-Division of Lots 1 and 2, Block 1 and Lots
3, 4, 5, 6, and 7, Block 2 of Irvine's Addition to City of Oelwein, Fayette County, Iowa.

WHEREAS, by Resolution # 5698-2025 the Council scheduled a Public Hearing on the
proposed sale of the above-described property for February 24, 2025 at 6:00 p.m., during the
regular City Council meeting to be held in the City Council Chambers, Oelwein City Hall, 20 2nd
Ave. SW, Oelwein, Iowa, and

WHEREAS, notice of the Public Hearing was published in the Oelwein Daily Register on
February 14, 2025, consistent with the requirements of §364.7 and §362.3 of the Iowa Code,
and

WHEREAS, the Mayor opened the Public Hearing, and the Council accepted public
comment, reviewed and considered any written comments received in advance of the Public
Hearing, and upon the conclusion of public comment closed the public hearing, and

WHEREAS, the City Council discussed the proposed sale of said real estate and found the
City did not have a continuing use for the property, that the property did not otherwise serve a
public purpose, and that the sale of said property would, therefore, be in the best interest of the
City, and

WHEREAS, the City Council also discussed the value of the real estate, the value to the
community of the potential uses for the property, and in consideration of the above and
foregoing, determined it to be appropriate and in the best interests of the City to approve the
sale of said property to Travis C. Staack for the sum of \$1,050.00.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the city of Oelwein, Iowa, as follows:

- Section 1. That the property described herein shall be transferred to Travis C. Staack for the
sum of \$1,050.00.
- Section 2. That the property is being sold as is.
- Section 3. That the property shall be transferred by Quit Claim Deed with no abstract to be
provided.
- Section 4. That the Quit Claim Deed, and related Clerk's Affidavit, shall be recorded at the
expense of the City.

- Section 5. The Mayor or City Administrator shall be authorized to execute the QCD, and any other documents related to the approved transfer of this property as set forth above.
- Section 6. Action on this Resolution shall be final upon the delivery of the Deed to the Buyer.
- Section 7. This resolution shall be in effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
