






Service area - North

Ambulance replacement

- Would replace a 2003 ambulance with 201,575 miles.
- New ambulance has added safety features not available on the 2003 model.
- Price includes the cost of a powered stretcher and loading system.
- There is a 2-year timeframe for building a new ambulance.
- Total cost of \$ 366,384.00
