- Police
 - Do we charge a person for an accident report?
 - No, the person in the accident gets it for free, insurance companies pay a fee
 - Should we make cats register?
 - No, the fees for dogs are almost always used after the fact
- Fire
 - Are we charging for fire service?
 - Yes, taxes have it so that you can have the truck be ready to come to your house
 - How do we charge for accidents and spills?
 - Those now fall under Motor Vehicle Accident Response and Motor Vehicle Accident Response with Extrication
 - Why are we making so many changes?
 - This will help clarify how to make charges in the future and simplify the billing

 - Council requested staff research hangar rent

 - Staff provides the following recommendations

| | Monthly | Annual | Proposed Monthly |

| Airport Hangar (East) | \$65/Month | \$780 | \$75 |
| Airport Hangar (West) | \$70/month | \$840 | \$80 |
| Airport Hangar (new) | \$90/month | \$1,080 | \$100 |
| Community Hangar | \$155/month | \$1,860 | \$175 |

- Recreation
