NOTICE REGARDING SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FROM THE IOWA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (IEDA) FUNDING FOR THE CITY OF OELWEIN SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT ALONG WITH A COMMUNITY NEEDS ASSESSMENT

The Oelwein City Council intends to submit an application for supplemental CDBG funding for their municipal sewer improvement project. The focus of this proposed project is the northeast portion of the collection system where the basement backups and sewer bypasses have been identified. The project consists of two improvement areas and is anticipated to take approximately eight months to complete. The Oelwein city council will also be discussing the community needs within the city.

The funding application will be submitted on or before July 1, 2022. The project will also be funded with local matching funds from the City of Oelwein. The intent of this notice is to provide citizens the opportunity to comment on the proposed project and application prior to submittal.
