Consent Agenda

1. Consideration of a motion approving the November 10, 2025 minutes.

2. Claims resolution in the amount of \$656,778.63.

Ordinances

- 1. Consideration of an ordinance amending Chapter 23: Miscellaneous Law Enforcement, Article IV Miscellaneous Prohibitions; Illegal Camping. First Reading.
 - 1. The city needs to have code to allow enforcement options if a person decides to camp within Oelwein other than a campground. While homelessness is a concerning issue, the city of Oelwein does not have the funding or resources to address this issue. Intervention from the county and state will be needed.

Resolutions

- 3. Consideration of a resolution encouraging the Fayette County Landfill Commission to study a transition from Population-Based Billing to Tonnage-Based Hauler Billing.
 - The city needs to have the Fayette County Landfill Commission move to a tonnage fee-based system. This will take the city out of the equation and help the city's audit. The City Administrator recommends approving the resolution.
- 4. Consideration of a resolution to approve entering a contract for design services with AECOM to Rehabilitate T-Hangar Taxilanes for the Oelwein Municipal Airport in the amount of \$55,600.00.
 - 1. This project has been on the airport capital improvement plan for many years. The pavement to the west of the airport needs repair. The City Administrator recommends approving the resolution.
- 5. Consideration of a resolution approving Change Order #1 in the amount of \$0.00 for 10th St. Bridge Reconstruction Project with Taylor Construction.
 - This change order is needed because the contractor has elected to use eticketing for PCC for this project. This requires a formal change order because this is a state project with many more hoops to jump through. The City Administrator recommends approving the resolution.
- 6. Consideration of a resolution approving Pay Application No. 2 in the amount of \$19,884.03 to Taylor Construction for the 10th St. Bridge Project.



- 1. This is the second pay app for the 10th street bridge application. Progress on the bridge has been satisfactory. The City Administrator recommends approving the resolution.
- 7. Consideration of a resolution setting a public hearing on December 8, 2025 at 6:00PM in the Council Chambers on the sale of west 25' of the east 65' of the south 64' of Block 1, Oelwein's Homestead Addition in the amount of \$1.00
 - 1. Selling this part of the parking lot will allow a future restaurant to expand their footprint of their building. The city will only sell the property for \$1.00 if the restaurant becomes operational. The City Administrator recommends approving the resolution.

Motions

- 8. Consideration of a motion to approve the Oelwein RISE CDBG 24-CF-002 Project Budget Amendment Request Letter.
 - 1. This project is a pass through. The city had to apply on behalf of RISE. RISE is using Upper Explorerland to administer the grant. The City Administrator recommends approving the motion.
