## **SUBJECT:**

Resolution 21-58, Recognizing the Renaming of Barclay Hills Neighborhood Association to Elyville Neighborhood Association

#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approving Resolution 21-58, which will officially recognize the renaming of Barclay Hills Neighborhood Association to the Elyville Neighborhood Association.

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The former Barclay Hills Neighborhood Association requests the City of Oregon City officially recognize the change of the association's name to "Elyville Neighborhood Association."

### **BACKGROUND:**

The City of Oregon City ("City") recognized the Barclay Hills Neighborhood Association on February 19, 1997 using Resolution 97-05. That resolution also incorporated and agreement with the neighborhood association.

Recently, the neighborhood association has discussed the history of the neighborhood, the various historical figures and locations in the neighborhood, and did not find that the name "Barclay Hills" was the preferred name for the area.

On November 9, 2021, the neighborhood association voted to change its name to Elyville Neighborhood Association. On December 2, 2021 the neighborhood association officially requested that the City recognize the association as the "Elyville Neighborhood Association" and the neighborhood as the "Elyville Neighborhood."

The name change does not alter the City's relationship with the neighborhood association. The changes to the name will be included with all subsequent resolutions, ordinances, policies, and other materials after adoption. This change will not

retroactively alter existing codes, resolutions, or policies, which will be updated along with other changes as they occur.
