Work Plan Item #7 Improving the Historic Review Approval Process- Revisit HRB Policy #12 Solar Panels

- Solar panel installations on visible elevations of historic buildings are becoming more acceptable due to the growing awareness of the importance of renewable energy and the need for green energy.
- This is a change from the past when the view was that all solar panels must be shielded from view to meet the Secretary of the Interior's standards for rehabilitation. Oregon City created a new solar panel policy a few years ago, but it requires all solar panels on main public viewing roofs to be reviewed at an HRB hearing.

## Work to Date

August 11, 2023 – CAMP presentation on the city of Denver's approach to Solar Panels

September 26, 2023: Adopted the 2023-2025 HRB workplan, potentially revising HRB policy #12 solar panels

**November 28, 2023 work session**: Review existing HRB policy and Denver's revisions; requests an additional work session with more photos of each example.

**February 27, 2024 work session**: Reviewed examples in PPT- no specific consensus on the approach to move forward; requested staff provide a "white paper" member to be able to review information to date.

**March 26, 20204** work session: Staff is looking to see if there is consensus to move forward on revision- or if HRB wants to monitor the issue and pursue additional reasons with a future work plan.
