SUBJECT:	Solid Waste Collection Rate Annual Adjustment (Discussion/Action)

City Council will consider rate adjustment from Waste Management requested due to increased operational cost.

BACKGROUND

City Council in 2020 approved a new solid waste collection franchise agreement with Waste Management, effective January 1, 2021. The agreement sets a formula for adjusting collection rates annually based on fuel prices, transfer station tipping fees, and the CPI.

DISCUSSION

The service rate increase of 1.8% will be effective January 1, 2025. The effective new rates include:

- The standard 64-gallon mixed solid waste cart is currently \$23.15/mo; the new rate schedule will be \$23.57, an increase of 42¢.
- Senior rate for 35-gal cart is \$16.67, will go to \$16.97.
- Optional green waste is adjusting from \$6.26 to \$6.37.
- Weekly service of a 4-yd commercial dumpster is adjusting from \$248/mo to \$252/mo.

RECOMMENDATION

Approved proposed adjusted 2025 rate schedule per the Waste Management Collection Franchise Agreement.

Fiscal Impact of Recommendation:

\$1400 projected increase in franchise fee payment Jan-June to City General Fund, but budget assumed 5% increase so net loss of \$2600 per budget.
