## 2024-2025 UNMET TRANSIT NEEDS THAT ARE REASONABLE TO MEET

Do you need a ride to work and Glenn Ride's schedule does not coordinate with your work hours? Do you need a ride to and from school or a doctor's appointment and public transportation is unavailable in your neighborhood? Do several of your neighbors have the same problem? These could be unmet transit needs.



The Glenn County Transportation Commission annually conducts a series of public hearings to obtain information on perceived unmet transit needs. The gathered information is analyzed to ensure that all "unmet transit needs that are reasonable to meet" are met before funds are used for non-transit uses such as streets and roads.

## Unmet Transit Needs that are reasonable to meet are required to meet the following standards:

**Cost Effectiveness:** The cost to provide the service will meet the minimum fare box recovery ratio of 10%, required by the Transportation Development Act.

**Economy:** The project can be implemented at a reasonable cost.

**Community Acceptance:** Support exists as indicated through the public hearing process.

**Operational Feasibility:** The service must be safe to operate.
