SUBJECT: Appointment of an Ad Hoc Committee to Review the Glenn County Property and Sales Tax Revenue Sharing Agreement

BACKGROUND

In 2015, the City of Orland and the County of Glenn entered into an Agreement for Apportionment of Property and Sales Tax Revenues Due to Jurisdictional Change in conjunction with the Westside (Travel Plaza) Annexation. The agreement established how property tax and sales tax revenues generated within the annexation area would be allocated between the City and the County.

As discussions regarding the agreement continue, staff recommends the formation of an Ad Hoc Committee consisting of two City Council members to meet with Glenn County representatives and staff. The committee will review the existing agreement, discuss potential revisions, and provide direction to staff as negotiations move forward.

DISCUSSION

The Ad Hoc Committee will:

- Review the existing Property and Sales Tax Revenue Sharing Agreement.
- Meet with Glenn County representatives to discuss the agreement and any proposed modifications.
- Provide feedback and recommendations to City staff.
- Report back to the full City Council as appropriate.

The committee will serve in an advisory capacity only. Any final agreement or amendment will be brought back to the City Council for consideration and approval at a future public meeting.

RECOMMENDATION

Appoint two members of the City Council to serve on an Ad Hoc Committee to work with Glenn County representatives regarding the Property and Sales Tax Revenue Sharing Agreement for the Westside (Travel Plaza) Annexation area.

FISCAL IMPACT OF RECOMMENDATION

There is no direct fiscal impact associated with appointing the Ad Hoc Committee. Any future fiscal impacts resulting from proposed amendments to the agreement will be presented to the City Council for consideration prior to approval.
