

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-50

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PAHOKEE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE CANCELLATION OF THE SEPTEMBER 9, 2025, CITY COMMISSION MEETING AND RESCHEDULING THE MEETING FOR SEPTEMBER 8, 2025; PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 200.065(2)(e)2., F.S., states “hearing dates scheduled by the county commission and school board shall not be utilized by any other taxing authority within the county for its public hearings”; and

WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners has its first budget hearing scheduled for September 9, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the School Board of Palm Beach County has its first budget hearing scheduled for September 10, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Pahokee (“City Commission”) desires to cancel the September 9, 2025, City Commission Meeting and reschedule the meeting for September 8, 2025, in order to hold a tentative budget hearing; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that cancelling the September 9, 2025, City Commission Meeting and rescheduling the meeting for September 8, 2025, is in the best interest of the City of Pahokee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PAHOKEE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Adoption of Representations. The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are hereby true and correct and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. Approval. The City Commission hereby approves the cancellation of the September 9, 2025, City Commission Meeting and rescheduling of the meeting for September 8, 2025.

Section 3. Conflict. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
