

RESOLUTION 2022 - 39

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PAHOKEE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE PAHOKEE MIDDLE/SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL 2022 HOMECOMING PARADE AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE THE PERMIT APPLICATION FOR THE HOMECOMING PARADE; PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Pahokee Middle/Senior High School desires to hold a 2022 Homecoming Parade on October 21st, 2022 at 2:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, in order for the Homecoming Parade to be held, a permit from the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") is required to close the roads along the specified route; and

WHEREAS, in order to secure a permit, the Florida Department of Transportation requires a resolution from the City Commission of the City of Pahokee, Florida (the "City Commission") indicating approval of the Homecoming Parade.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PAHOKEE, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Adoption of Representations. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. Approval of Parade. The City Commission hereby approves the Homecoming Parade to be held by Pahokee Middle/Senior High School on October 21st, 2022 at 2:00 p.m.

Section 3. Authorization of City Manager. The City Commission hereby directs and authorizes the City Manager to execute a permit application for the Homecoming Parade.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
