

RESOLUTION 2026-19

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PAHOKEE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE POLLING LOCATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS OFFICE AND THE CITY OF PAHOKEE, ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A"; PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The City Commission of the City of Pahokee ("City") desires to enter into an Agreement between Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections Office and the City; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Agreement is to provide Election Day polling location services for the Primary and General Election Days scheduled for the Countywide 2026 Election Cycle; and

WHEREAS, City agrees to provide a Polling Location for the Primary and General Election scheduled to be held on August 17, 2026 and November 2, 2026, respectively; and

WHEREAS, the City will provide access to the Polling Location no later than 5:30a.m. on Election Day.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PAHOKEE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Adoption of Representations. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. Authorization. The City Commission of the City of Pahokee, Florida hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into an Agreement for Election Day Polling Location between the City of Pahokee and Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections Office, attached hereto as Exhibit "A." The City Clerk is further authorized to take all necessary and expedient action to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
