

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-38

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PAHOKEE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT AGREEMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026/2027 BETWEEN THE CITY OF PAHOKEE AND PALM BEACH COUNTY FOR FUNDING OF CODE ENFORCEMENT SERVICES, AS SET FORTH HERETO IN EXHIBIT "A"; PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County has entered into an agreement with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Program in certain areas of Palm Beach County, pursuant to Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (as amended); and

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County has made available Forty-Five Thousand Four Hundred and Eighty-six Dollars (\$45,486.00) in CDBG funding to the City of Pahokee for the provision of code enforcement services and specifically for the enforcement of applicable housing and building codes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pahokee will utilize the aforementioned CDBG funds to pay all or a portion of the salary and benefits of one full time Senior Code Enforcement Officer; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Pahokee ("City Commission") deems it to be in the best interests of the residents of the City of Pahokee to approve this CDBG grant agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PAHOKEE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Adoption of Representations. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. Approval and Authorization. The City Commission of the City of Pahokee hereby authorizes the Mayor and City Manager to enter into a CDBG Agreement for FY 2026-2027 between the City of Pahokee and Palm Beach County for funding of Code Enforcement Services, attached hereto as Exhibit "A." The City Manager is further

authorized to take all necessary and expedient actions to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. Conflict. All resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby and expressly repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
