The City Commission of the City of Pahokee hereby authorizes the Mayor and City Manager to execute the Lobbyist Services Agreement between _______. and the City of Pahokee, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" on an emergency basis. The City Manager is further authorized to take all necessary and expedient action to carry out the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
