SUBJECT: Big Dog Express of South Florida, Inc Hurricane Milton Storm Debris Removal

GENERAL SUMMARY/BACKGROUND:

The City of Pahokee was in need of storm debris removal from Hurricane Milton that occurred on October 12, 2024. The City Manager approved emergency storm debris removal services by our contracted waste management provider Big Dog Express and is now seeking ratification from the City Commission for the services rendered from October 12, 2024 to October 21, 2024 costs.

Big Dog Express of South Florida, Inc, removed 7,440.54 cubic yards of storm debris these costs are for loading, hauling (trucking) to debris site located in Pahokee, grinding and hauling to final destination for disposal of vegetation waste.

BUDGET IMPACT: Yes - \$143,973.34 – reimbursable by FEMA
