

RESOLUTION 2025-68

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PAHOKEE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE CITY OF PAHOKEE'S ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARADE AND AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR A PARADE PERMIT FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Pahokee desires to hold its 2025 Christmas Parade on December 15, 2025 at 6:00 PM; and

WHEREAS, in order for the Christmas Parade to be held, a permit from the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") is required to close state roads; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Pahokee ("City Commission") desires to approve a Christmas parade concept and further desires to authorize an application to be completed with the Florida Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, in order to secure a permit, the Florida Department of Transportation requires a formal Resolution from the City Commission showing approval of the desired Christmas Parade.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PAHOKEE, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Adoption of Representations. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. Approval of Parade. The City Commission hereby approves Annual Christmas Parade to be held by the City of Pahokee on December 15, 2025 at 6:00 PM.

Section 3. Authorization of Permit Application. The City Commission hereby authorizes the application of a permit to be applied for from the Florida Department of Transportation for the Annual Christmas Parade. The City Manager is further authorized to take all necessary and expedient actions to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
