

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-34

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PAHOKEE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO REJECT ALL BIDS FOR REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) 2026-01 FOR INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, On March 3, 2026, the City of Pahokee ("City") issued Requests for Proposals (RFP 26-01) for Information Technology (IT) Consulting Services; and

WHEREAS, the formal bidding period concluded on March 27, 2026, with the City receiving submissions from four IT firms; and

WHEREAS, on April 17, 2026, the RFP Review Committee invited the four proposers to deliver formal presentation; and

WHEREAS, following the presentations, the RFP Review Committee ranked the respondents as follows: 1) Global Solutions Group; 2) Coastal Network Solutions; 3) TQUAL; and 4) LASC Informatics; and

WHEREAS, during the evaluation process, City staff identified significant concerns regarding service delivery related to the proposals and following a comprehensive review, the City Manager recommends that an additional option for service delivery be explored and considered by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, as a result, the City Manager is proposing that the City Commission reject all bids for Request For Proposal RFP 26-01 for Information Technology Services; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that authorizing the City Manager to reject all proposals for RFP 26-01 for Information Technology Services is in the best interest of the City of Pahokee.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PAHOKEE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Adoption of Representations. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. Rejection of All Bids. The City Commission hereby adopts the recommendation of the City Manager and rejects all bids related to RFP 26-01 for Information Technology Services.

Section 3. Conflict. All resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby and expressly repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
