

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-44

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PAHOKEE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE PAHOKEE MIDDLE/SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL 2026 HOMECOMING PARADE AND AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR A PARADE PERMIT FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Pahokee Middle/Senior High School desires to hold a 2026 Homecoming Parade on September 25, 2026; and

WHEREAS, in order for the Homecoming Parade to be held, a permit from the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") is required to close state roads; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Pahokee ("City Commission") desires to approve the Homecoming Parade concept and further desires to authorize an application to be completed with the Florida Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, in order to secure a permit, the Florida Department of Transportation requires a formal Resolution for the desired Homecoming Parade.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PAHOKEE, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Adoption of Representations. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. Approval of Parade. The City Commission hereby approves the Homecoming Parade to be held by Pahokee Middle/Senior High School on September 25, 2026.

Section 3. Authorization of Permit Application. The City Commission further authorizes application of an MLK Parade permit from the Florida Department of Transportation. The Mayor, City Manager, and City Clerk are authorized to take all necessary and expedient actions to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
