GENERAL SUMMARY/BACKGROUND:

Palm Beach County Office of Community Revitalization has awarded the City of Pahokee Parks & Recreation Department two (2) NEAT (Neighborhood Engagement And Transformation) Grant for FY2022-2023.

The 1st NEAT Grant – MLK Park: This will allow the Parks & Recreation Department to procure & purchase materials to repair MLK Park – sidewalks, restroom sanitation mitigation efforts, repair open pavements and concession area; perform exterior pressure cleaning & painting.

The award amount from the NEAT Grant is: \$10,000.00 with a required match from the City of Pahokee of \$10,000.00 = TOTAL PROJECT FUNDING = \$20,000.00

The 2nd NEAT Grant – Commissioners Park: This will allow Parks & Recreation Department to procure professional services to repair and make improvements to the splash pad.

The award from the NEAT Grant is: \$10,000.00 with a required match from the City of Pahokee of \$10,000.00 = TOTAL PROJECT FUNDING = \$20,000.00

<u>BUDGET IMPACT</u>: A TOTAL of \$20,000.00 will be the match needed from the City of Pahokee as a requirement to fulfill the terms of the NEAT Grant.

The PBC Office of Community Revitalization will fund the City with two (2) \$10,000.00 grants for MLK Park and Commissioners Park repair & improvements.
