RESOLUTION NO. 39-2021

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE SIGNING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA) WITH THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (CDOT) FOR DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS FOR BRIDGE REHAB PROJECT IN THE TOWN OF PALMER LAKE, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado, pursuant to Colorado statute and the Town of Palmer Lake Municipal Code, is vested with the authority of administering the affairs of the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees has authority over agreements for the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town was awarded funds for a CDOT project to rehab two bridges; and

WHEREAS, authorizing signature to the IGA accepts funds and authorizes signature for the disbursement and to conduct rehabilitation work on the Town bridges.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PALMER LAKE, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Town Board of Trustees hereby authorizes signature to the Intergovernmental Agreement with Colorado Department of Transportation as described in the attached Exhibit A.
2. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each part or parts thereof irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.
3. Repeal. Existing resolutions or parts of resolutions covering the same matters embraced in this Resolution are hereby repealed and all resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.
