RESOLUTION NO. 43-2025

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING WASTE CONNECTIONS OF COLORADO INC. AS THE PREFERRED PROVIDER OF TRASH AND RECYCLE REMOVAL SERVICES FOR RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES WITHIN THE TOWN OF PALMER LAKE, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado, pursuant to Colorado statute and the Town of Palmer Lake Municipal Code, is vested with the authority of administering the affairs of the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to facilitate residential trash removal and recycling services for its residents on an economical basis; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board desires to reduce large truck traffic on Town roads; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees requested and received proposals from several providers of such services and carefully considered their proposals; and

WHEREAS, based on the presentations the Board received, the Board concluded that the proposal received from Waste Connections of Colorado Inc., was the most beneficial to the Town and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PALMER LAKE, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Board of Trustees for the Town of Palmer Lake hereby accepts the proposal of Waste Connections of Colorado Inc., to provide trash and recycle removal services for residential properties at the rate of Seventeen Dollars (\$17) per month per residence for two years as set forth in their proposal dated February 28, 2025, including weekly service per home for one 96 gallon trash tote and up to three extra bags placed beside the tote.
- 2. The Board designates Waste Connections of Colorado Inc., as the preferred provider of such services, recommending their use by all residents of the Town in order to achieve the economies of scale they offer.
- 3. The Board understands and supports that Waste Connections of Colorado Inc. will seek information to service commercial accounts within the Town and provide a proposal to the Board for preferred commercial services.
- 4. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each part or parts thereof irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.
