

**RESOLUTION NO. 2025-02**  
**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS**  
**OF PALMER LAKE SANITATION DISTRICT**  
**OPTING OUT OF THE GRAYWATER CONTROL PROGRAM**  
**AND PROHIBITING THE USE OF GRAYWATER WITHIN**  
**PALMER LAKE SANITATION DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS**, on May 29, 2024, the Governor of Colorado signed into law House Bill 24-1362 which, among other things, permits the use of graywater for certain purposes and authorizes the Colorado Water Quality Control Commission to adopt rules implementing HB 24-1362 and regulating graywater use; and

**WHEREAS**, the Colorado Water Quality Control Commission has promulgated Regulation 86, effective January 14, 2024, the Graywater Control Regulation, which is set forth at 5 CCR 1002-86; and

**WHEREAS**, Regulation 86 establishes a complex graywater control scheme which could potentially require Palmer Lake Sanitation District (“District”) to develop an oversight program including permitting and design, inspection, and enforcement; and

**WHEREAS**, the District does not presently have the resources to develop and implement a graywater oversight program; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to C.R.S § 25-8-205.4, the District Board of Directors (“Board”) has the authority to opt out of the Graywater Control Program and to adopt a Resolution prohibiting the installation of graywater treatment works as defined in C.R.S. § 25-8-103(8.4), and the use of all graywater within the District and to so notify the Division of Administration within the Department of Public Health and Environment; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has determined that it would be in the best interests of the District, consistent with principals of fiscal responsibility and sound stewardship, to opt out of the Graywater Control Program and to prohibit the treatment and use of graywater within the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board hereby finds, determines and declares that adoption of this resolution is necessary for the preservation and protection of the public health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the District.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Palmer Lake Sanitation District Board of Directors that:

1. The installation of graywater treatment works as defined in C.R.S. § 25-8-103(8.4) is prohibited within the District.

2. Use of graywater as defined in C.R.S. § 25-8-103(8.3) is prohibited for all purposes within the District.

3. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption and shall remain in effect until amended or repealed by subsequent Resolution.
