RESOLUTION NO. 25-2022

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE SIGNATURE TO A LETTER OF SUPPORT FOR COLORADO RURAL WATER ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado, pursuant to Colorado statute and the Town of Palmer Lake Municipal Code, is vested with the authority of administering the affairs of the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the Town intends to utilize the apprenticeship program for a water operator for the Town of Palmer Lake; and

WHEREAS, Colorado Rural Water Association is seeking support for the successful apprenticeship program to utilize grant funding opportunity; and

WHEREAS, Town staff supports the apprenticeship program and requests the Board of Trustees to authorize a letter of support for the program funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PALMER LAKE, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Town Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the Mayor and Town Administrator to sign the enclosed letter of support for Colorado Rural Water Association apprenticeship program.
