

PLP&T Parks maintenance needs - current and projected

1st Draft: brainstorming August 7, 2024, updated 9/5/2024

Centennial Park

Trash around the Lake shore - pickup 2-3 times per week June 1 to September (Labor Day)

Pet waste stations and trash cans

Restroom (East side) - per agreement with EPCP

Restroom on the West side - TBD

Snow shoveling off the pedestrian bridge - as needed

Pickle ball court gates etc as determined after meeting with APL rep

Collecting dead and fallen branches around the Lake - as needed

Mowing the west side gazebo area - as needed

Little League field - ???

Posting any facility reservations as needed

Empty fishing line disposal tubes as needed, report any missing caps

Columbine Park

Pet station and trash can

E-Rock pavilion and trail

Pet waste station(s) and trash can(s) at pavilion and around the trail once installed - next year

Mow grass in the upper fields in the fall, otherwise leave "wild"

Mow grass 1 yard either side of the trail where it goes through the tall grass

Posting any facility reservation once pavilion is renovated

Mowing around the open air pavilion - maybe 15' mowed area from the walls

Glen Park

Mow the west end from Walnut to the tennis courts once or twice each summer as needed

Leave the West end unmowed, natural, except for mowing 1 yard on either side of the trail

Empty pet waste stations and trash cans - playground, tennis/PB courts as needed

Deliver wood chips to the playground closest to Lovers Lane side in late spring before

Service in the Parks Day.

Coordinate with PLP&T for the spreading of the chips on a Service in the Parks day

Rake pea gravel back under the swings in the tall swing area 1 or 2 times/yr as needed

Address dead trees and fallen limbs as needed

Inform PLP&T of any needs to comply with CIRSA inspection and coordinate correction

Creekside Trail

Assist PLP&T with any maintenance needs along the trail as needed - mowing 1 yard either side of the trail through tall grass

Dead and falls limbs, trees removal

Removing any overgrown brush that limits line of sight along the trail, coordinate with PLP&T for work to be done during a Service in the Parks Day
