Subject: FW: Disc Golf

Greg, I met with Tim yesterday morning at the bridge to discuss an idea that Tim has that would potentially benefit all parties and fit into the Centennial Park master planning underway.

Tim's ideas include a number of things:

1. Tim and Awake Palmer Lake have, with the agreement of Parks and the Board of Trustees, submitted a grant concept and application for 6 pickle ball courts in the open area north of the Pedestrian Bridge west entrance, east of the parking lot along 105 and west of the RR fence, south of the first two DG holes.
2. The grant would also be for a rest room facilities in the parking lot area (actual location to be determined) south of the same west bridge entrance.
3. He is suggesting that all 18 disc golf holes be located on the east side of the bridge and RR tracks, with holes 1 and 18, in the area immediately below the east exit of the bridge. Hole #1 would be closely accessed from the parking lots mentioned above.
4. Hole 18 is a perfect example of that as the golfers finish they can go up the to be shortly installed steps and cross the bridge to their cars, bathroom, restaurants.
5. The shifting of holes outlined would also make it unnecessary to cross the RR tracks (an ongoing problem) as a short cut to access the next hole.
6. The area where the first tee and hole are currently would become a shaded picnic area for park users on the west side, the only such area on the west side.
7. Following up on an earlier conversations - can you send me your request for cut logs to be used on the course so that I can pass them along to PLVFD? Nothings longer than 6-8'?
