**RESOLUTION NO. 22-2025**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AGREEMENT TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR THE LOCATION OF A PUBLIC SAFETY FACILITY IN THE TOWN OF PALMER LAKE**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado, pursuant to Colorado statute and the Town of Palmer Lake Municipal Code, is vested with the authority of administering the affairs of the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town has interest in considering the best location for a combined Police and Fire public safety facility; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees secured planning monies from Department of Local Affairs (DOLA) with an award of \$12,500 Energy/Mineral Impact Assistance Fund grant and budgeted a match of \$12,500 in the 2025 budget; and

**WHEREAS**, a Request for Qualifications was advertised and solicited to several firms with a deadline of February 3, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, a review team including Police Chief Smith, Fire Chief Vincent, and Deputy Town Clerk Romero reviewed the two proposals received and recommends the proposal from Ryan Koeniger of Architetto Design Studio, in collaboration with Ron Conder of Architivity Ltd, for the feasibility study.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PALMER LAKE, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Town Board authorizes the Mayor to sign the attached Professional Service Agreement, to complete a feasibility study for the best location of a possible combined public safety facility, at a total cost not to exceed \$25,000.
2. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each part or parts thereof irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.
3. Repeal. Existing resolutions or parts of resolutions covering the same matters embraced in this Resolution are hereby repealed and all resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.
