A RESOLUTION APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN FUNKY LITTLE THEATER CO., AND TOWN OF PALMER LAKE, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado, pursuant to Colorado statute and the Town of Palmer Lake Municipal Code, is vested with the authority of administering the affairs of the Town of Palmer Lake, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the Funky Little Theater Co., seeks support from the Town of Palmer Lake for the performances brought to the community; and

WHEREAS, performances are a substantial benefit to the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Palmer Lake may permit the Theater use of the historic town hall; and

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) attached as Exhibit A, sets forth the agreement of the parties as to the conditions and responsibilities for each party.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PALMER LAKE, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Town Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the Mayor to sign the MOU, attached as Exhibit A.
- 2. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each part or parts thereof irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.
- 3. Repeal. Existing resolutions or parts of resolutions covering the same matters embraced in this Resolution are hereby repealed and all resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.
