## Patient Centered Care

The Home Health department has initiated monthly quality meetings to provide focused time to review quality measures, incidents, and processes. This team effort is a proactive approach to improving departmental processes, documentation, communication and ultimately the care provided to the community. It is guided by the Home Health QAPI plan.

## Facility

The Quality Committee for LTC and CAH will meet on November 20<sup>th</sup>, to review this month’s data and provide updates on identified action items. Additions to the committee include Amy O’Connor and Rachel Kandoll with Infection Prevention.

The Quality Infrastructure Assessment will be submitted this week as part of the Medicare Beneficiary Quality Improvement Project (MBQIP.) The purpose of the National Critical Access Hospital (CAH) Quality Inventory and Assessment is to learn more about CAH quality improvement infrastructure and activities, service lines offered, and related quality measures. The Assessment gathers a wealth of information on QI processes from CAHs in a standardized manner, in order to enhance support to CAHs in quality improvement activities. PMC will also receive state and national comparison information related to the data collected.
