I am the Infection Preventionist for PMC.

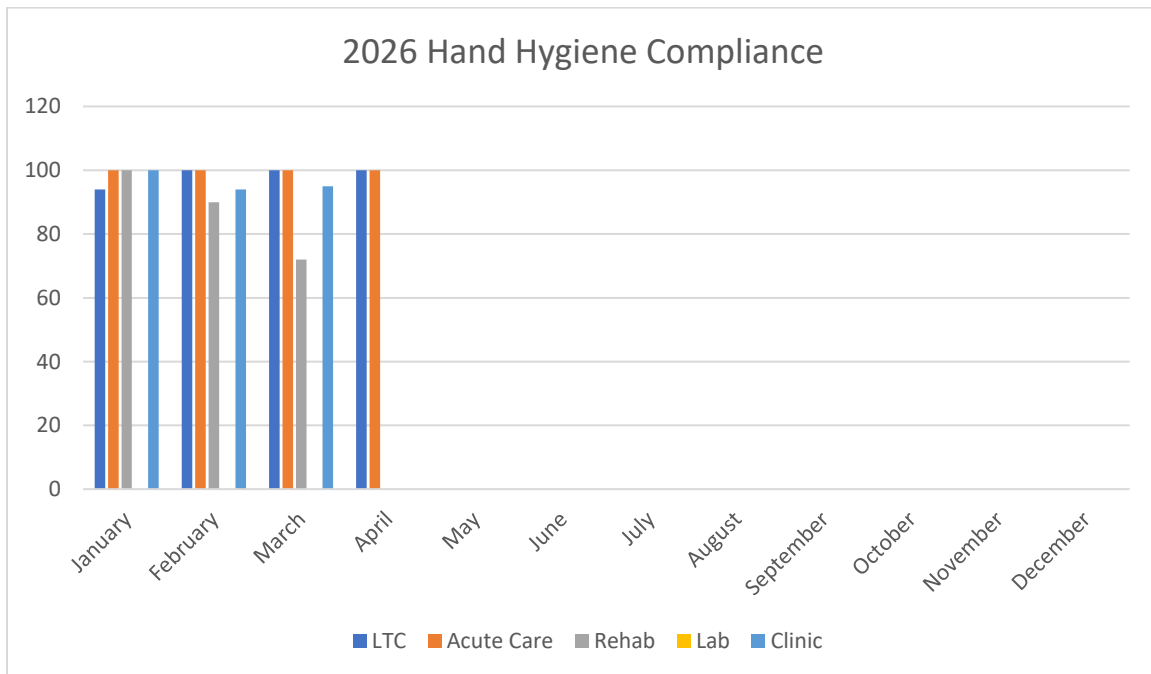
### Community Engagement

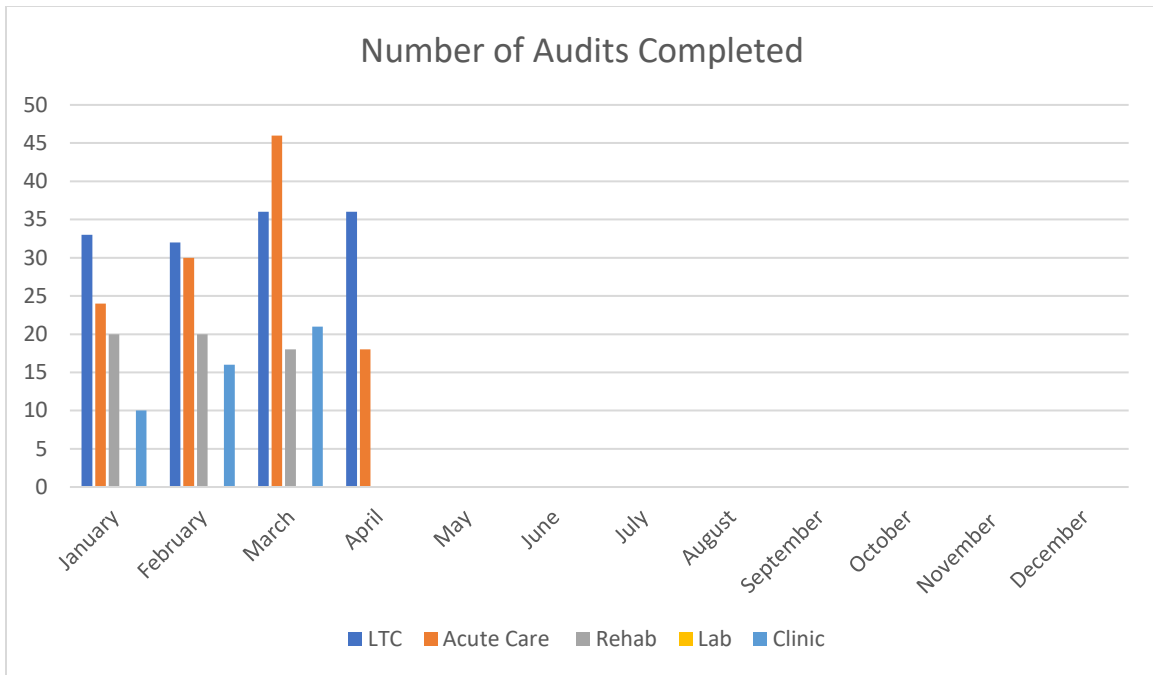
I work with many different departments at PMC to ensure compliance with regulations, including nursing, EVS, home health, physical therapy, clinic and lab.
