I am the lone Infection Preventionist for PMC.

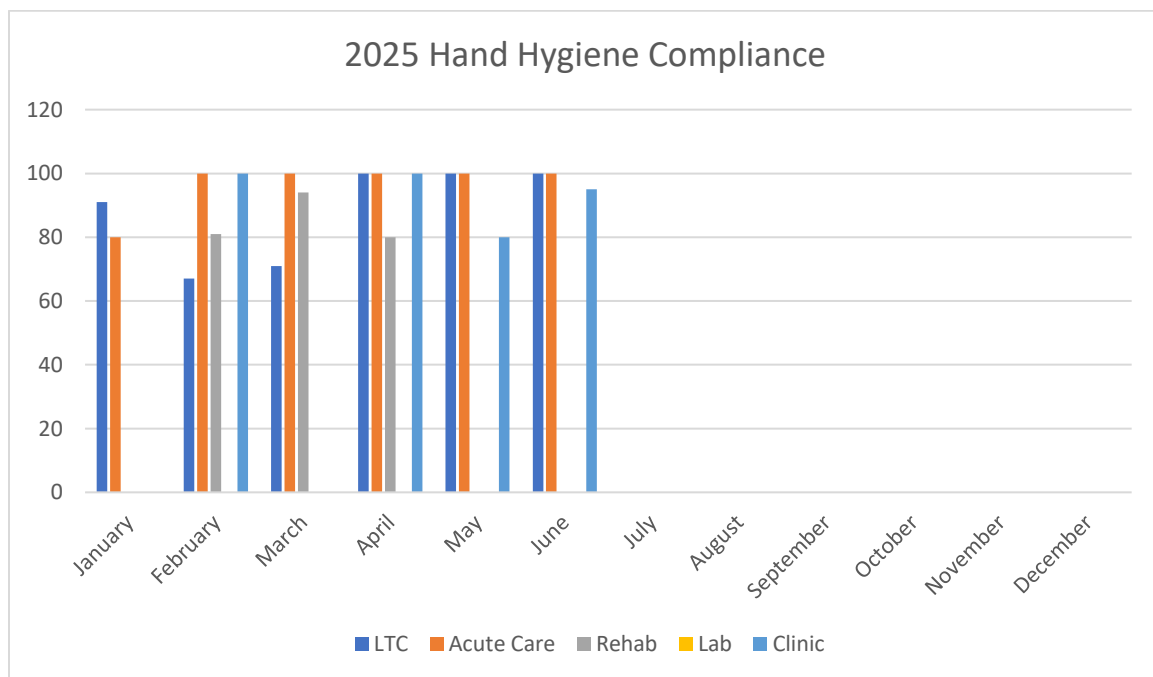
Community Engagement
