

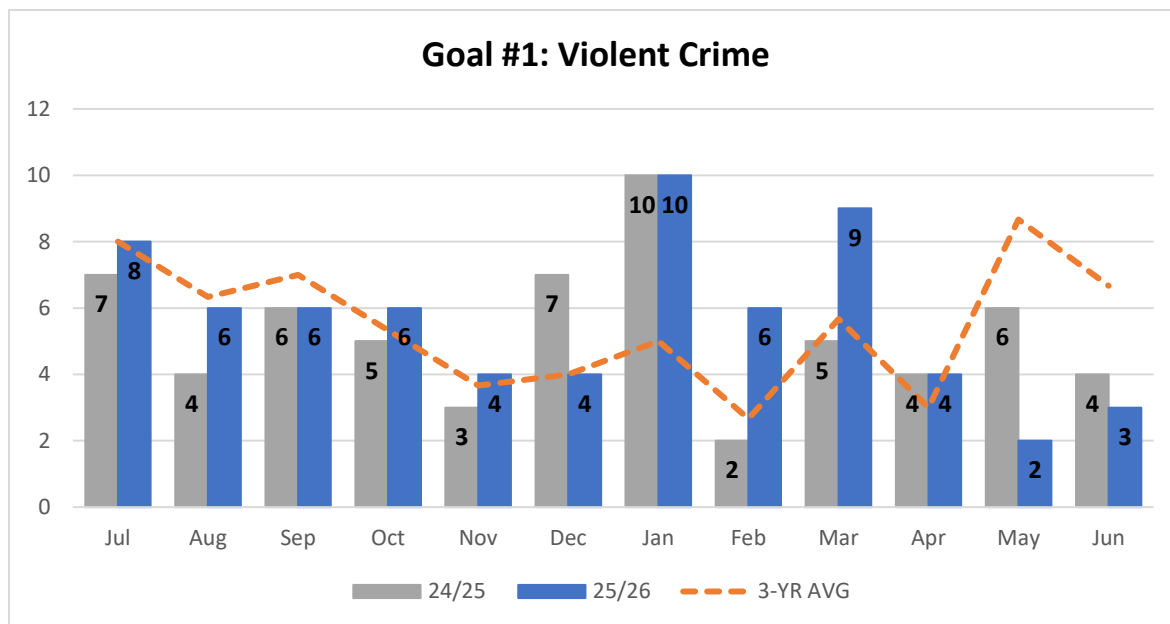

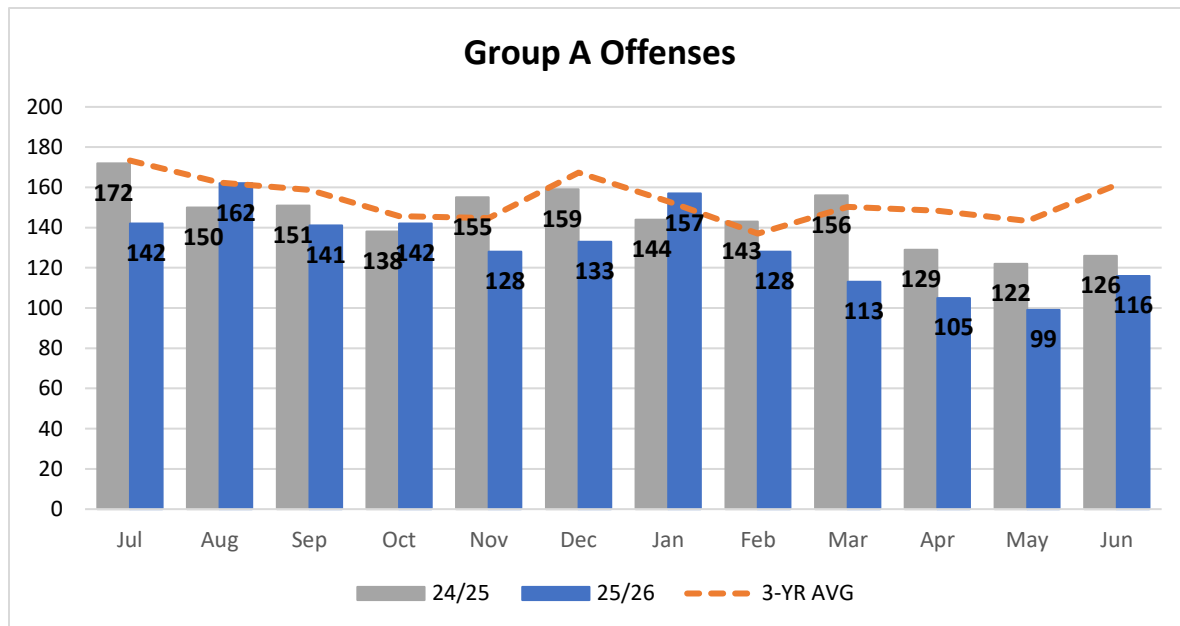
June 2026

Comparison to Jul '24 to Jun '25: -10%

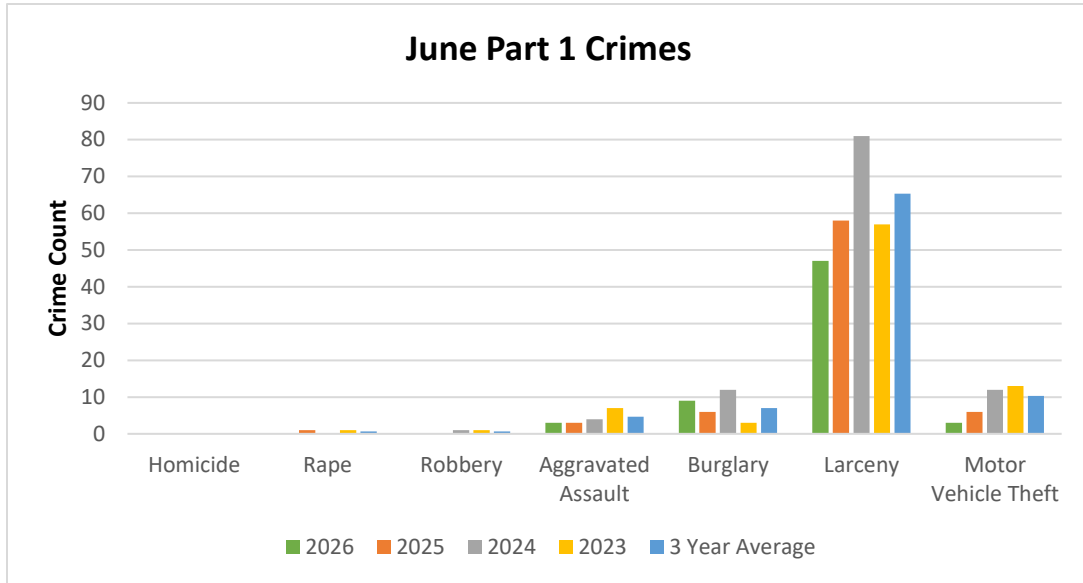
Comparison to Jul to Jun- 3 Year Avg: -15%

Below is a table and bar graph of the counts for Part 1 Crimes in June. For comparison, the same is shown for the past 3 years. The average of the 3 years was calculated.

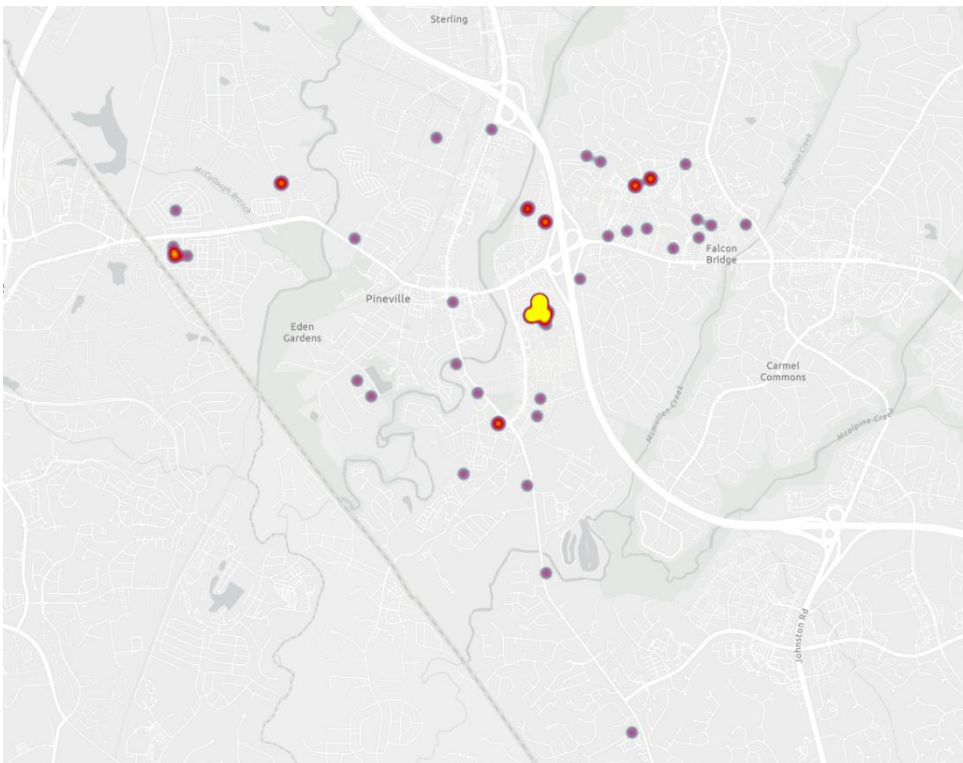

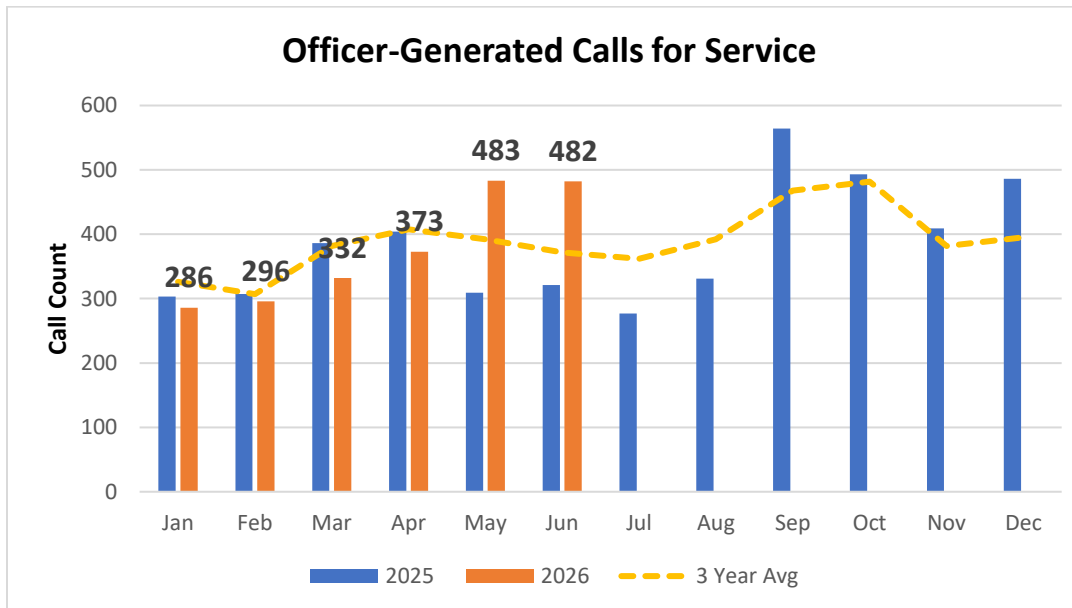
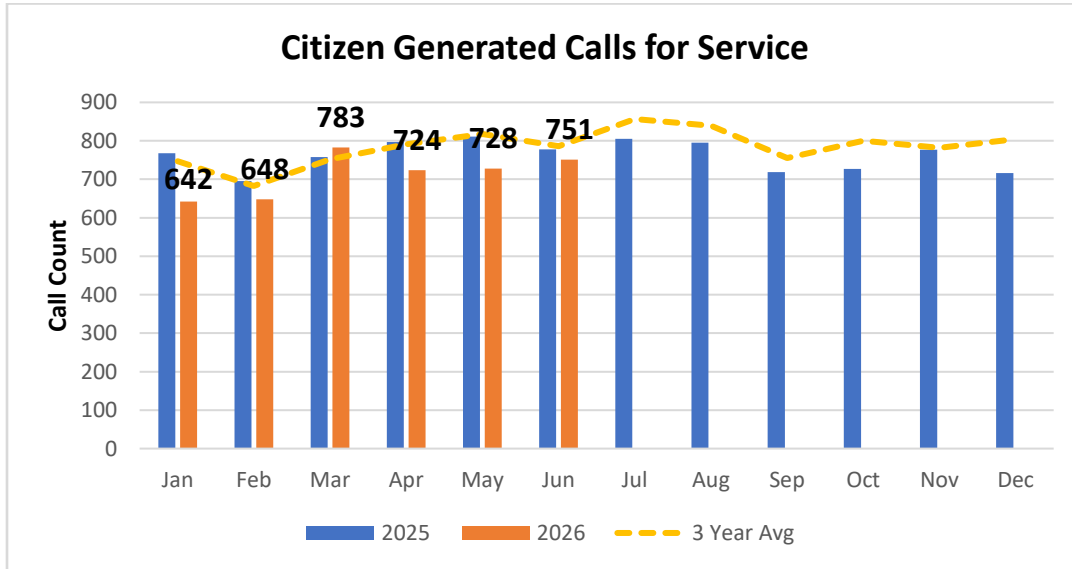
Top Crimes Mapped

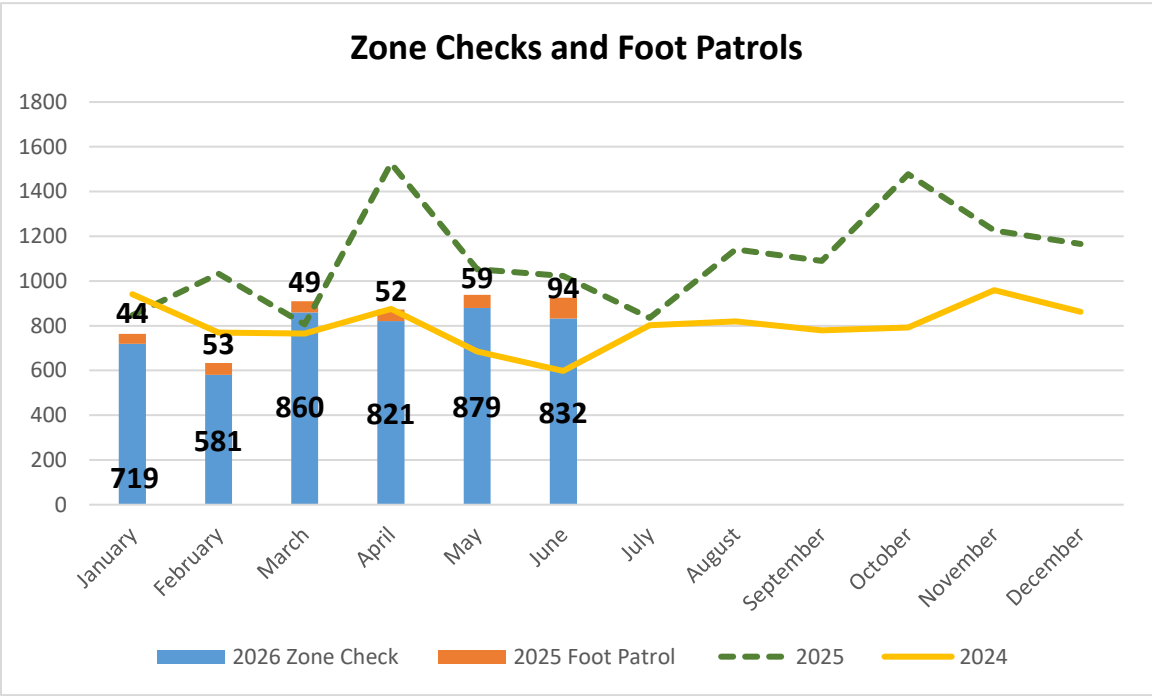
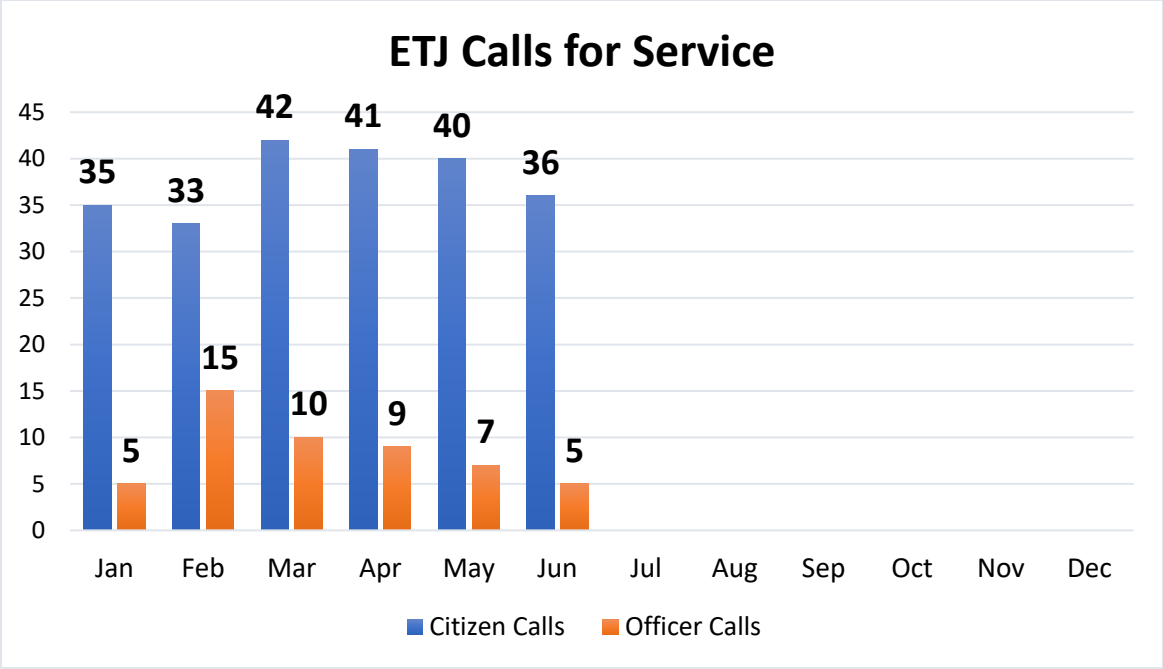
