

Crime Goals




Comparison to Jul '24 to Jan '25: -6.4%

Below is a table and bar graph of the counts for Part 1 Crimes in January. For comparison, the same is shown for the past 3 years. The average of the 3 years was calculated.





Top Crimes Mapped





Calls for Service
