

#### Crime Goals




**Comparison to Jul '24 to Dec '24: -8.3%**

Below is a table and bar graph of the counts for Part 1 Crimes in December. For comparison, the same is shown for the past 3 years. The average of the 3 years was calculated.





**Top Crimes Mapped**


## Calls for Service


